Doris Jean "D.J." Hash, 83, of Damascus, VA passed away on Sunday, May 30, 2021 at her residence. She was born in Rockingham County, NC, on August 22, 1937, a daughter of the late John and Margie Newnam. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Charles Donald Hash; son, Gary Wayne Hash; brother, Lloyd Newnam; and sister, Carolyn N. Cox.

She had lived and worked for the FBI in Washington, D.C. until 1967 then moved to Green Cove, VA. D.J. had a career in banking and retired from First Virginia Bank, aka BB&T in 1994. In October of 1995 she began working for the Damascus Senior Citizens Corporation and District III Governmental Cooperation of Marion until her retirement in 2019.

She was a member of Damascus Road Baptist Church in Abingdon, former member of Green Cove Missionary Baptist Church where she served as Sunday school teacher from 1967 until 1988.

She is survived by her daughter, Janet Hash Pennington and her husband, Steve; granddaughter, Rachel LeighAnn Pennington; and special nephew, David Wayne Cox.
